These fine-line FPCs can run the entire length of the catheter and into the proximal handle with continuous, uninterrupted traces. 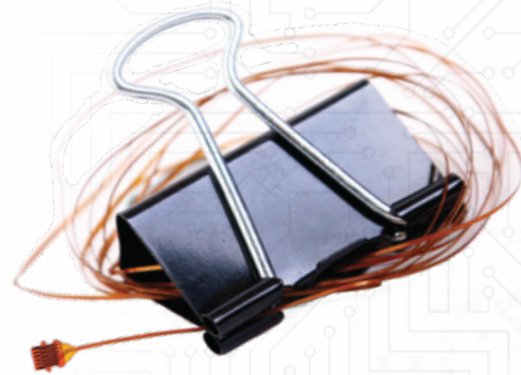

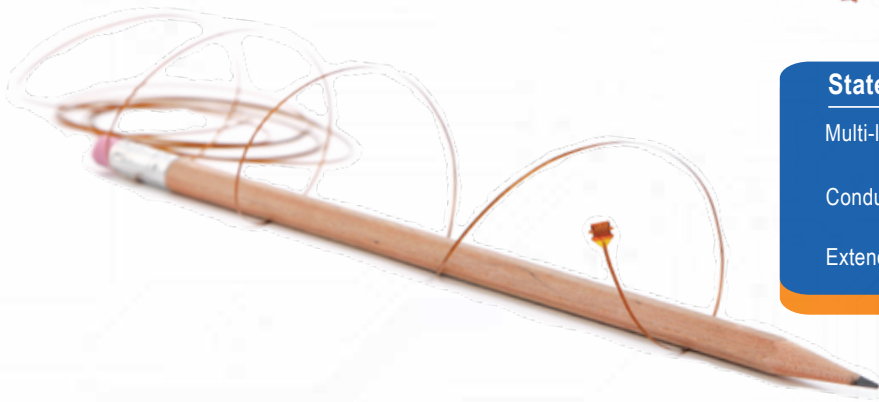
## Mainline Production

Multi-layer construction up to 4 conductive layers.  
Conductor density of 4 mil (100  $\mu\text{m}$ ) trace and space.  
Extended length up to 64" (1.6m) total.



## State of the Art - Advanced Circuits

Multi-layer construction up to 8 conductive layers.  
Conductor density of 2 mil (50  $\mu\text{m}$ ) trace and space.  
Extended length up to 108" (2.75m) total.
